He was a respected community figure, holding the position of Captain, Auxiliary Police Officer in the SCPD 1<sup>st</sup> precinct for two decades. Anthony was also a leader at one of the largest companies on Long Island; Broadridge Financial Solutions, Inc. for three decades. His leadership skills, integrity and humility were exemplified by his ability to guide others through difficult times and achieve success.
